Penn Resilient Wheels-PCC Super Resilient

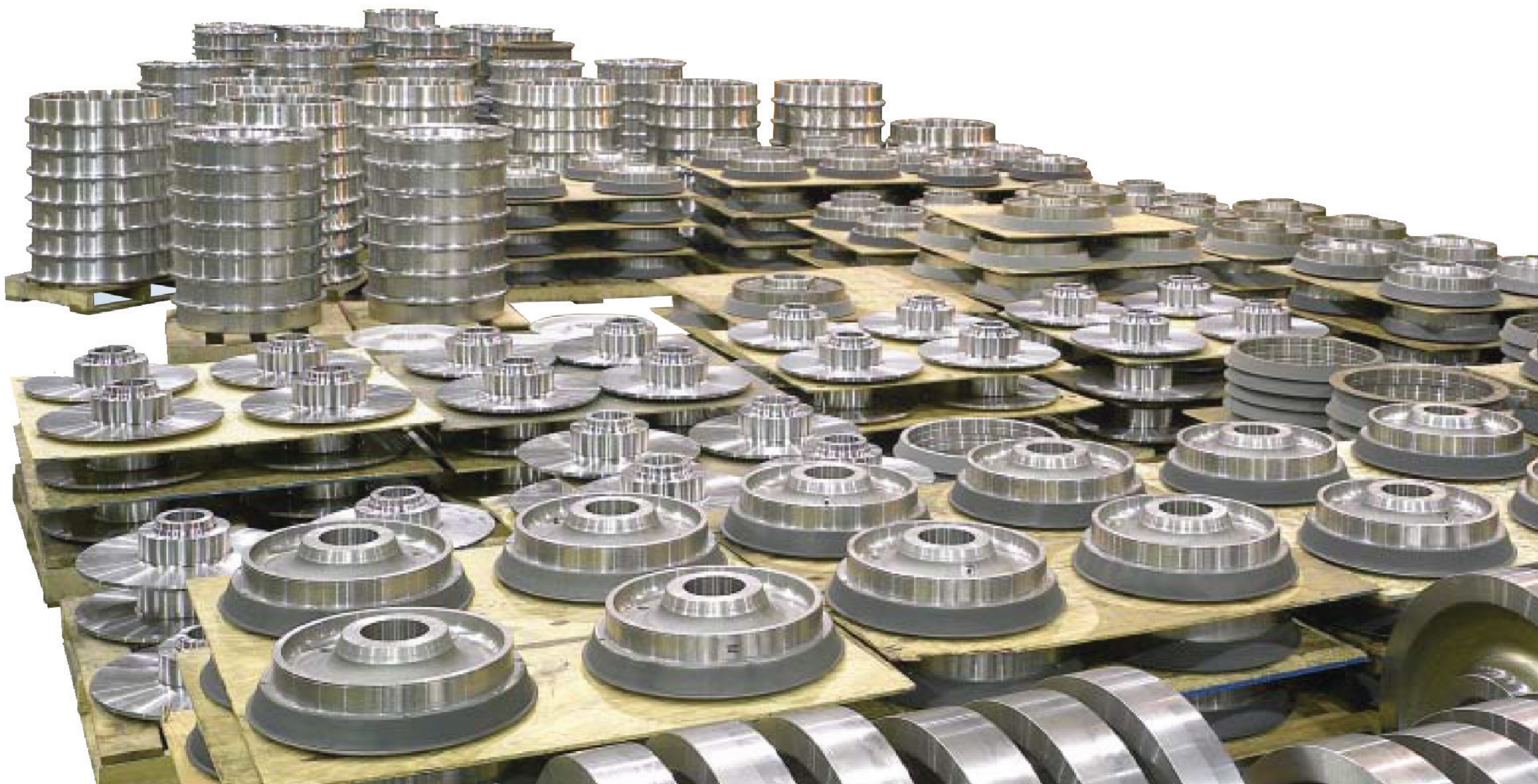

Advantages of Resilient Wheels

- Improved ride quality

Design/Construction Features

All Penn Machine resilient wheels have an elastic layer between the steel tire and wheel center. This elastic layer is comprised of a number of individual rubber or ring elements with precisely matched elasticity and damping properties. These wheels have the required conductive continuity through the independently rotating wheels to the axle shaft via external current conductors. This divided wheel body facilitates dismantling and refitting of the wheel tire, and can be performed under the vehicle in the appropriate installation situation.





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Why PCC Super Resilient Wheels?

- Tires can be changed without removing wheel set from truck (inboard bearing design)
- Tires can be changed with axle in horizontal position
- Less cost to change tires
- Softer radial direction
- Firmer lateral direction
- Can be custom designed for wheels 25-inch or larger
- Tire changing equipment is portable, resulting in less capital investment
